St. Jerome's church addition and alterations were designed to maintain its original integrity and character while also meeting the needs of their parish family. The new main entrance addition allowed for the removal of the exterior stairs and construction of an enclosed handicap accessible, street level entrance. A new vestibule on the lower level was located immediately inside the new entrance and led to a handicap accessible elevator and interior stairs. The elevator provides service to the second floor worship space and the third floor balcony level choir loft. The main level addition also has a new vestibule/gathering space which is ideal for greeting parishioners after Mass, as well as during special liturgies such as weddings, first communions and funerals.
